desire to break free of any limitations.

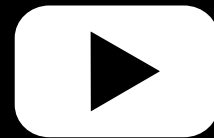
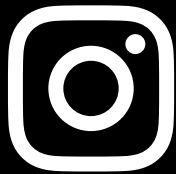
Now, the band is simply driven by a
